"Argentina's new government has replaced the country's consul in Miami, Guillermo Jacovella, after only 11 months on the job, Argentine officials said Friday.

Jacovella, a former Ambassador to Spain, said he was taken by surprise by a foreign ministry cable Thursday ordering him to leave Miami and return to Buenos Aires. 'They didn't give me any explanation,' Jacovella said.

A spokesman for the Argentine foreign ministry said the decision was part of 'changes in the institutional diplomatic structure' and suggested the new government wanted a new diplomat in a city he described as 'a key influence area' for Latin America and Argentina.

The financially strapped government of President Eduardo Duhalde has in recent weeks replaced its Ambassadors to Washington, The Organization of American States and several Latin American countries. Critics say each ambassadorial or consular change costs at least \$60,000 in moving expenses and airfares for the two families involved.

'As a matter of policy, our union believes that career officers shouldn't be replaced until the end of their missions,' said José Sanchis Muñoz, president of Argentina's Professional Association of Foreign Service Officials, APCPSEN.

Jacovella is likely to be replaced by Ambassador Luis María Ricchieri, another career service officer who held senior positions at the foreign ministry and served as Argentina's consul in Los Angeles, foreign ministry officials said."
